ECONOMY

WPI Inflation Jumps to 9.68 Percent; New PPI Series Launched

Wholesale Price Index (WPI) inflation rose to 9.68 percent in May 2026, up from 8.3 percent in April, driven mainly by a surge in fuel and power prices amid West Asia tensions. The same day, the government rebased the WPI from 2011-12 to 2022-23 and launched India's first set of Producer Price Indices (PPI). The WPI is released by the Office of the Economic Adviser, the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT).

INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

India-Slovakia Ties Elevated to a Comprehensive Partnership

During the first-ever visit by an Indian Prime Minister to Slovakia, India and Slovakia elevated their relationship to a Comprehensive Partnership, signing memoranda of understanding on labour migration and digital technology. PM Modi held talks with Slovak Prime Minister Robert Fico and President Peter Pellegrini, who welcomed the India-EU Free Trade Agreement.

India and France Adopt the Innovation Roadmap 2030

On the France leg of the visit, at Nice, India and France adopted the India-France Innovation Roadmap 2030 with a set of outcomes spanning artificial intelligence, space, trade and education, including a Joint AI Working Group and an Economic Security Dialogue, and a target to double bilateral trade in five years.

ENVIRONMENT

Global Wind Day: India Targets 100 GW by 2030

On Global Wind Day, India spotlighted a path to 100 GW of installed wind capacity by 2030 and 155 GW by 2035. India's installed wind capacity reached 56.09 GW in March 2026, the fourth largest in the world, with a record 6.05 GW added in 2025-26.

SECURITY AND DEFENCE

Army Releases "Army Uniforms-2026" Dress Code

The Indian Army released a 174-page "Army Uniforms-2026" pamphlet, its first comprehensive update in eight years, dropping colonial-era terminology, formally approving the closed-neck Bandi jacket for officers and introducing a Battle Jacket winter dress to be phased in by June 2029.

Jharkhand Wins GI Tags for Four Products

Four traditional Jharkhand products received Geographical Indication tags: Bhagaiya silk (Godda district), Kuchai silk (Seraikela-Kharsawan district), Munda tribal jewellery, and Jharkhand bamboo craft. The tags, facilitated by NABARD, are granted under the Geographical Indications of Goods Act, 1999.
